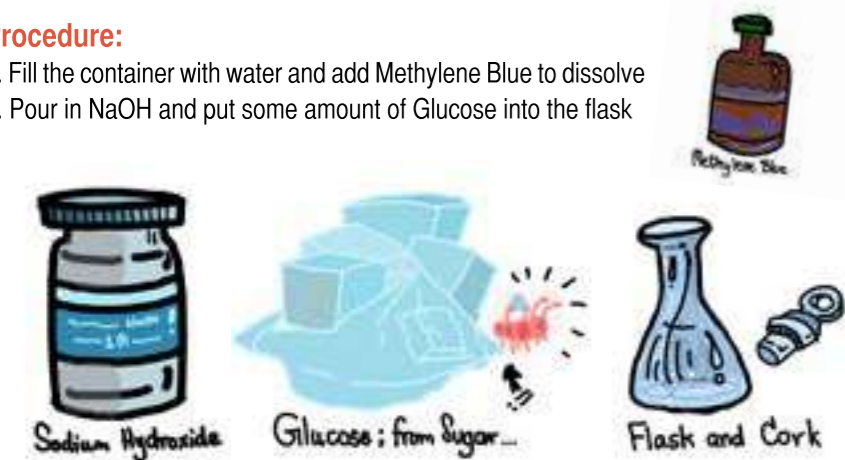
1. The Blue Bottle Experiment

The Blue Bottle Experiment, conducted by Secondary 5 students, was one of many experiments during EP Science Week. Normally, when the bottle or flask stays at an idle state, the aqueous solution inside appears colorless. If you shake it, the solution turns in blue. How could this amazing thing happen?

Materials used included - Methylene Blue; usually in the blue liquid or oxidized form, Sodium Hydroxide or NaOH; alkaline substance to quicken the reaction, Glucose or C₆H₁₂O₆; the reducing agent to turn the Methylene Blue into colorless form, Oxygen gas, O₂ in the air; the oxidizing agent to turn the Methylene Blue into blue form and a flask or glass bottle with cork; to fill the solution for the experiment and turn it into a closed system

Procedure:

1. Fill the container with water and add Methylene Blue to dissolve
2. Pour in NaOH and put some amount of Glucose into the flask



3. Stir the solution with a glass rod to mix the components together and observe the physical change of the solution; the color changes! But how?!

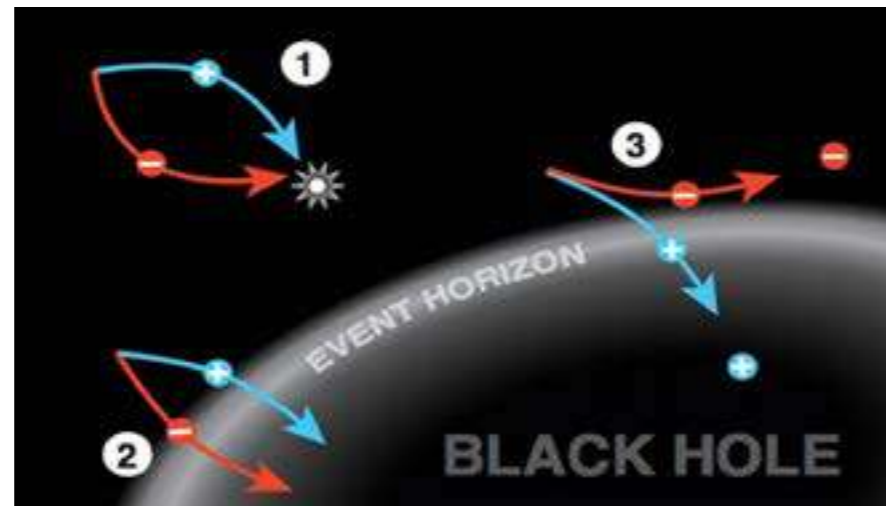


Factor: Normally, Methylene Blue is active in the oxidized form. When it is shaken, the oxygen gas in the air reacts with it and turns

the solution blue. Methylene Blue turns into transparent color after the bottle stops shaking which is caused by a reduction reaction between the Methylene Blue and glucose.

2. The sun isn't yellow but white...

The light that travels from the sun and passes through the earth's atmosphere is actually white. In the atmosphere, light is separated into a spectrum by dust particles and molecules in the air. The spectrum is what makes up the white light and can be separated by objects of different density, thereby refracting into various colors. Humans, however, only see a few of them: the rainbow colors, which include the refraction of the yellow color of the sunlight and the blue color of the sky. This explains not only why the sun is yellow, but also why our sky is blue!



3. The Hawking Radiation

The Hawking Radiation is the emission of energy escaping a black hole. Normally, matter has an opposite twin called anti-matter which forms and annihilates each other into energy randomly around the universe. When a formation of matters and anti-matters occurs at an event horizon, it produces an opposite motion away the black hole's gravitational force. The matter or anti-matter which is repulsed is known as radiation from the event horizon and travels along the outer space in the energy form. This Hawking radiation process continues occurring until the black hole completely evaporates which takes trillions of years. Maybe this radiation will be the last thing that will happen before the universe ends.



4. Where does gold come from?

During the previous centuries, alchemists, people who try to change one element to another, tried to change lead into gold. Unfortunately, none of them succeeded because they missed something about chemistry. Natural gold came from the galaxy far far away...from an ancient massive star. The star began the process of fusing elements together in very high temperature called "Nuclear Fusion". This process forms heavy elements: from hydrogen to helium and ending at iron. After the star's explosion or supernovae, these irons captured the neutrons and developed themselves into heavier elements, including gold. Thanks to the explosion, its force spread gold and other elements to the outer space. Finally, it grouped together during Earth's formation, which was later dug up and used by us nowadays for jewelry decorations and electronic conductors.

ACSP TRAVELS TO INDONESIA FOR THE MODEL U.N.

NETHERLANDS WINS BEST POSITION PAPER

MEET INDONESIA---With more than 18,000 islands and located 2,327 km. away from Bangkok, Indonesia constitutes the largest archipelago in the world and a fantastic country to visit. After spending four hours in the air, twice before and after customs, a six-member Model United Nations (MUN) squad arrived at their destination—Jakarta.

Generally speaking, regarding the urban appearance, Jakarta is quite prosperous and bustling. A convenient metro system provided at the Soekarno-Hatta airport allows passengers to grab their luggage and transport to where their accommodations are. Be aware about the vehicles, however, as they are really fast and usually do not wait for people to cross the road. With the dedication of its diligent citizens, you can feel the whole city growing and modernising.

MEET MUN---The whole event was set at The Celeceton hotel. The councils were on the second floor and the accommodations for the delegates were on the third floor and higher.

UNSC---The aim of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) is to maintain international peace and security. Under the topic of "cyber warfare", 15 countries were invited to attend the meeting, including the 5 permanent members (P5) and 10 other countries. Our team was given 2 countries—Poland and the Netherlands.

The conferences were filled with debates and negotiations between nations to come up with comprehensive and effective solutions to disintegrate global security issues. Beforehand, we must assure that we have done enough research on the topic. We started from the factors of cyber-attacks

and later on dug into the types of assault, the corresponding solutions with a ranked priority for different situations, and the possibilities. With these, our position papers were formed. Before the first conference, we, the delegates of Poland and Netherlands, focused on what we were going to say, cleared our minds, and then walked into the UNSC committee.

One of the important aspects is the award for Best Position Paper which the Netherlands team consisting of Natkrit (Boss) and Ruiqi (Richard) won. The position paper includes a brief introduction followed by a comprehensive breakdown of your country's position on the topics that are being discussed by the committee, or an essay covering a country's perspective on the assigned topics of a conference.

To not be irrelevant in the council, we delivered our speech and ideas, collected others' opinions, defined unconfirmed conditions, and determined an intelligible frame-

work of the issues to compose the resolution paper—the final blue print of the issue.

In the evenings, parties were held. It's a great chance to socialise with the others, and meeting new people is the best experience. To talk with them, encounter new attitudes, improve your social skills—this greatly enhances someone's personal ability when on your own.

Be brave; just communicate as much as you can. We made mistakes and we managed to improve. They made mistakes and they amended when they realised. Do not be embarrassed—never! No matter who are you talking to, it's more likely a shame if no one from your team interacts with people. For the delegates of the Netherlands, Natkrit (Boss) is very good at socialising, and while Ruiqi (Richy) kept silent the first day, he became a little bit braver as time progressed. As for the delegates of Poland, Phakinee (Best) is extremely friendly and appeal to everyone while Ganchai (Saint) is a super smart observer and is good at handling relationships.

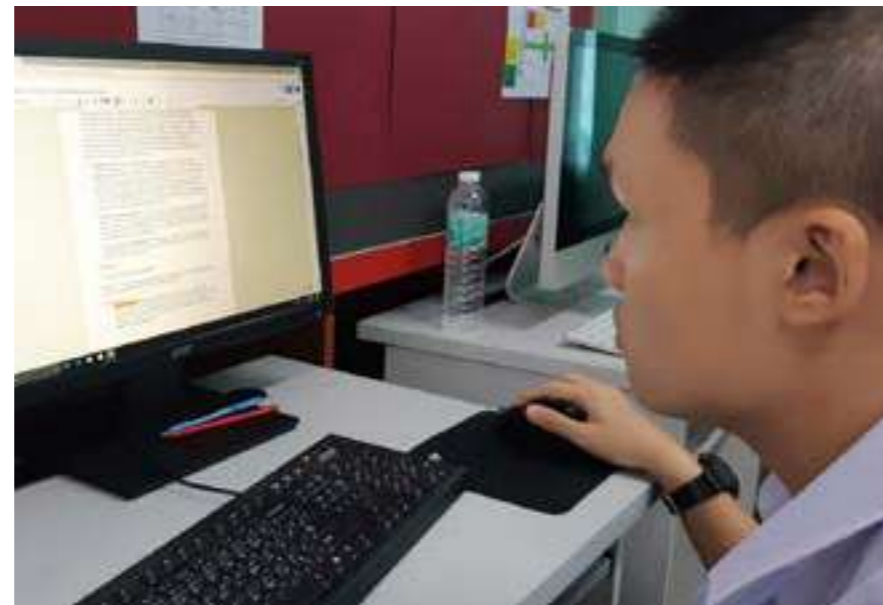

half of the shell has approximately eighty to one hundred feathers (estimation); together they form one side of the half-moon shell. It was astonishing for me, such a delicate pattern to unfold before my eyes. The inside of the Opera House, as long as I could see, was a nice restaurant. I don't know the name of it and I just don't want to eat there. I assumed the costs were barely acceptable for my family, and I knew I was right. Do not try fancy restaurants in Australia casually, my sincere advice.

I stayed there for two hours and then headed to our accommodation. No need to say the Opera House is a great place to have a look, despite the terrible traffic, we all agreed that was a spot worth seeing.

that such a big city doesn't have a way to carry people to the most famous scenic spot straight away, but I'm telling you this is true.

Eight hundred meters is not a long distance but when it is accompanied by the crowded throngs from other continents of the world, it got hard to walk. In addition to the countless taxis, deafening noises, and blocked streets, the nerve-wracking traffic situation created different levels of chaos. As a result of this, it took almost 1

hour to approach the Opera House.

So, what does it look like? A shell? Well, of course, but to be straight to the point: it's white, it reflects, it has plenty of stairs beneath it, it is a smaller than you think.

The Opera House has 8 rooftops, 2 small and 3 big on the left side, and the other 3 big on the right hand. The outer wall is decorated with white ceramic tiles, tiny pieces, around 6 by 6 cm. The gaps between two pieces of tile are clear to ob-

serve when you get close to it but mainly invisible to long-distance shooting. The majority of us deemed that the surface of the Sydney Opera House is smooth and spotless; to me, from my close encounter, the exterior is a grid-like wall. Each twenty to thirty pieces of tile is composed of a feather shaped "V", one's top connects to the next one's bottom; moreover, the feathers curve horizontally plying up the main structure and also keeping it straight vertically, like crystal white flakes! Each

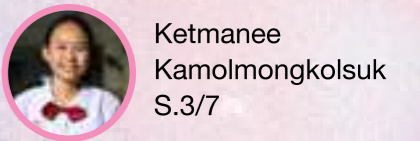

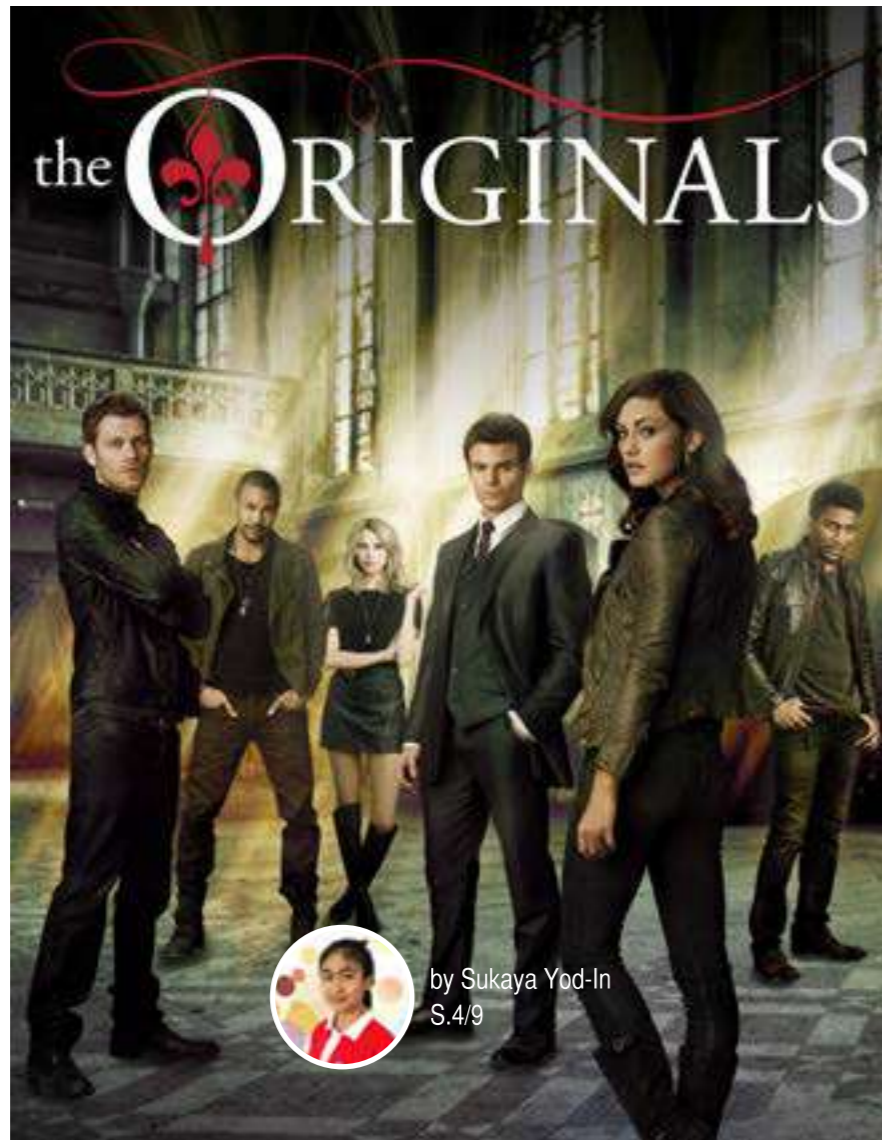
Polynesians play the sport called "Ula-MaiKa". The player must roll the rock to

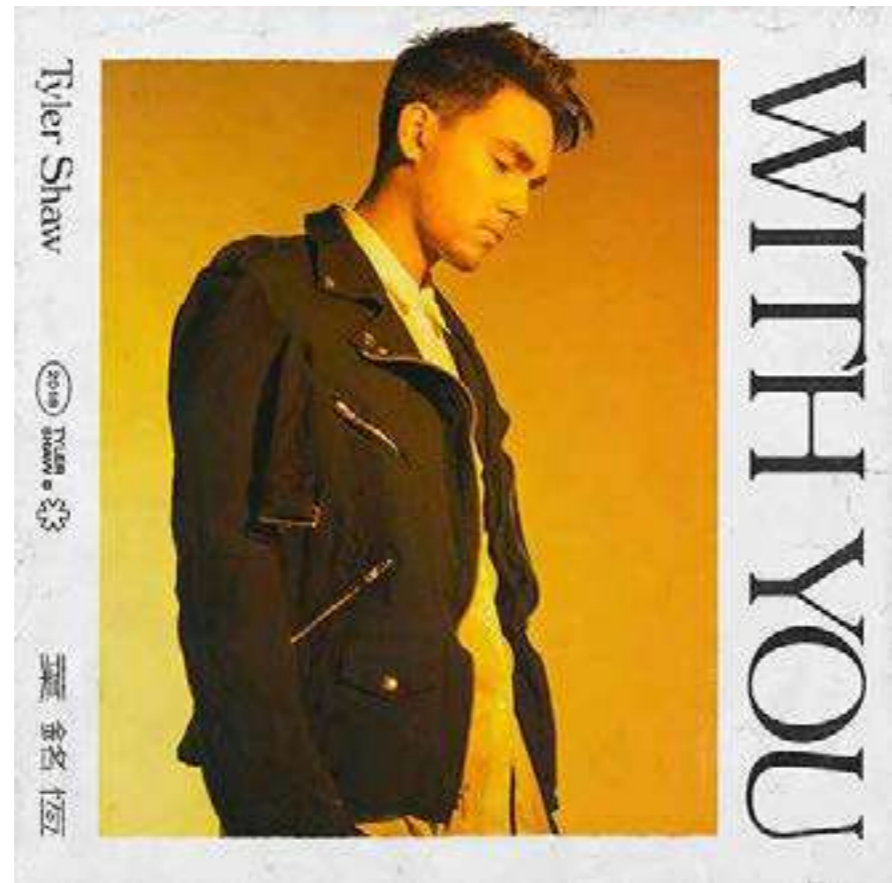


WRITER'S FAVOURITES FROM 'INTUITION'
